Bruce Andrews: Back on track after cancer surgery

Vietnam veteran and marathon runner Bruce Andrews prides himself on being competitive. This Brooklyn resident says it's a trait that's served him well in his 31 years as a hardware wholesaler.



Receiving a lung cancer diagnosis at age 76 was

"a tough pill to swallow," for Bruce, who has never smoked. "I was still running and winning races, so it was hard to believe," he said. "But my surgeon told me that up to 20 percent of lung cancer cases in the U.S. occur in people who have not smoked regularly."

Despite the shocking news, Bruce felt fortunate to consult with Mohan Kulkarni, M.D., a thoracic surgeon with Henry Ford Jackson Hospital. Dr. Kulkarni is internationally known for his expertise in robotic and minimally invasive procedures. "Whether or not someone has a history of smoking, it's important to raise awareness of the prevalence of this disease," Dr. Kulkarni said. "Lung cancer kills more Americans than breast and colon cancers combined."

Rebecca Parrow: Breast cancer survival is a team effort

Throughout her more than 20 years as an oncology pharmacist, Rebecca Parrow has supported many patients receiving chemotherapy. When she learned she had early-stage breast cancer, Rebecca said, "I resolved to control what I could and become a better person from the experience."



Rebecca's complex case was coordinated by medical oncologist Devin Malik, M.D. He advocated for Rebecca even before the two of them had a chance to meet by consulting with radiologists, surgeons, and radiation oncologist Annette Kretzler, M.D.

General surgeon Shawn Obi, M.D., also spoke with Rebecca about her cancer diagnosis and recommended genetic testing to determine the best course of action. Dr. Obi then coordinated Rebecca's meeting with plastic surgeon Diana Flis, M.D., so breast reconstruction could begin on the same day as surgery. Together with her providers, Rebecca chose a personalized course of treatment that began with radiologists David Williamson, M.D., and Samir Parikh. M.D.

Rebecca is now fully recovered and back to the job she loves. Her current work takes her to chemotherapy infusion clinics throughout Michigan. "I have not found [a hospital] that has more compassionate staff or is better run than at Henry Ford," she said.

This summer, a ribbon-cutting ceremony took place for our Cherished Infants Mausoleum, which provides a memorial and a dignified resting place for babies in our community.






